


Offa's Dyke: Knighton to Presteigne to Kington to Newchurch to Hay-On-Wye











Offa's Dyke: Hay On Wye to Longtown to Llangattock to Monmouth










Gower coastal path: Swansea to Nicholaston Farm to Hillend (Rhossili) to Llangennith







OFFA'S DYKE

Offa's Dyke is a formidable earthwork, begun c. AD 785 by order of Offa, King of Mercia (r. AD 757 - 796), and stretching for 82 miles roughly along the English - Welsh border.

Mercia was a huge Anglo - Saxon Kingdom covering most of central England; the dyke marked its western frontier, bordering Welsh territory. Originally about 27m wide and 8m high, it also served as a symbol of Offa's great power.

This three mile section is in the care of English Heritage.

Please take care exploring the site.

Supervise children closely.

Metal detecting, smoking, commercial photography and drone use are prohibited.




